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What is the relevance of the course?

India's approach to Solid Waste Management (SWM) has evolved significantly, with a strong emphasis on sustainability and circularity in recent years. The Solid Waste Management Rules, 2024 underscores the government's commitment to improving waste management practices across the country. These rules mandate every Urban Local Body (ULB) to develop an integrated waste management systems, promote segregation at source, and encourage home composting and material recovery, among other initiatives. Therefore, there is an urgent need for a professional approach that leverages expertise, technology and investments.

Public-Private Partnerships (PPPs) emerge as a crucial tool in this endeavor, offering a private sector while complementing government initiatives.

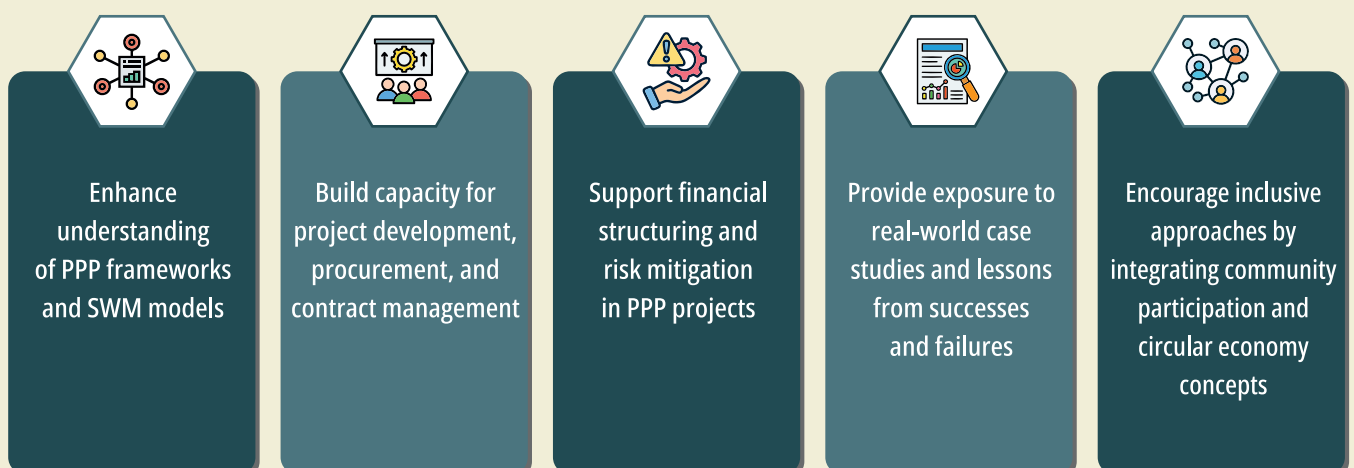
The Swachh Bharat Mission 2.0 further emphasizes the governments commitment to improve solid-waste management leading to a surge in demand for waste management solutions, creating an opportunity for PPPs to thrive. Despite the potential of PPPs, their implementation in the SWM sector remains limited, with most initiatives focusing on primary and secondary waste collection rather than processing, treatment and disposal. This highlights the need for Capacity building and expertise in structuring, executing and managing PPP based SWM projects.

In response to these challenges, the Administrative Staff College of India (ASCI) is introducing a certification programme for PPPs in municipal solid waste management. This programme is tailored to address the current skill gap in the urban SWM sector and unlock sustainable PPP solutions for urban waste management.

What is the core objective of the course?

The programme objective is to impart knowledge and skills to urban practitioners in structuring and managing PPPs, enabling them to tackle the complexities of solid waste management effectively.

Where is the venue?

The residential programme will be held at the Bella Vista Campus of ASCI. The participants will be accommodated in air-conditioned single occupancy rooms. The college does not provide accommodation for the family. The college is Wi-Fi enabled in a comprehensive way.

What is the duration of the course?

The programme duration is 3 days starting from December 16 to 18, 2025. The participants are expected to arrive a day before commencement and may leave after the conclusion of the programme.

Who would deliver the course?

Expert faculty comprising national and international PPP specialists and practising managers will facilitate dynamic sessions, sharing invaluable insights and experiences. They will also extend mentorship support for effective learning.

What is the programme fee?

Residential Fee: Rs. 43,700/- (US \$683 for foreigners) plus GST as applicable (presently 18%) per participant.

Non-Residential Fee: Rs. 37,700/- plus GST as applicable (presently 18%) per participant.

GST is not applicable for Urban Local Body Officials.

The fee covers tuition, board and lodging, courseware (in electronic form) and other facilities of the College including internet usage.

A discount of 10% on the Programme fee for three or more participants from the same organisation will be given, provided the payment is credited into our Bank account before December 12, 2025.
